KOGARAH BAY RADIO YACHT CLUB SAILING INSTRUCTIONS FOR 2008

Club Championship is scratch racing. There will be two series with four rounds in each. Ten races are to be sailed in each round. If the ten races can't be completed by 4.00pm then the racing will be extended by consensus for up to an hour so racing can be completed. If racing isn't complete by 5.00pm the number of races for the day will be those completed by 5.00pm. To allow boat tuning there will be a five minute break (if needed) after the first, fourth, and seventh races. Medals will be awarded to the top three in each series. Points will accumulate throughout the year for the Club Championship Shield.

Club Point Score is handicap racing. There will be two series with four rounds in each. Ten races are to be sailed in each round. If the ten races can't be completed by 4.00pm then the racing will be extended by consensus for up to an hour so racing can be completed. If racing isn't complete by 5.00pm the number of races for the day will be those completed by 5.00pm. To allow boat tuning there will be a five minute break (if needed) after the first, fourth and seventh races. Medals will be awarded to the top three in each series. Points will accumulate throughout the year for the Point Score Shield.

In the event of a postponement of Championship or Point Score days, racing will be rescheduled to the next Open Day unless otherwise notified.

Open Day is an informal day with racing, but no results are recorded. Any class and **visitors are welcome to join in.**

To compete in **Club Point Score** and **Club Championship** Skippers must be associate members of KBSC.

Racing commences at 1:00pm Sharp in ESST and 12:00 Sharp in EST. Race fees are \$4 per day, payable to the O.O.D.

Trophy Racing: Handicap racing. There will be ten races. The first two races will seed the handicaps. The remaining eight races are to be completed by 4.00pm. If the remaining races can not be completed by 4:00pm then the number of races for the day will be those completed by 4.00pm. To allow boat tuning there will be a five minute break (if needed) after the first, third and fifth races. Trophies will be awarded to the winner of each race and to the overall 1st, 2nd & 3rd place holder for the day.

Racing commences at 1:00pm. Race fees are \$3 per day, payable to the O.O.D.

In the event of a postponement racing will be rescheduled to the next Open Day unless otherwise notified.

To compete in Skippers must be associate members of KBSC.

Marathon Day: Handicap race. There will be one race. The existing handicaps held by the PointScore coordinator will be used to calculate handicaps for this race. The Marathon Day will be a single handicap race, comprising of a maximum of thirty (30) laps of a "Triangle" course to be completed by 4.00pm. If the remaining laps can not be completed by 4:00pm then the competitor with the highest number of laps will be the winner for the day. Trophies will be awarded to the winner of each race and to the overall 1st, 2nd & 3rd place holder for the day. For more information see the KBRYC website.

Racing commences at 1:00pm. Race fees are \$3 per day, payable to the O.O.D.

In the event of a postponement racing will be rescheduled to the next Open Day unless otherwise notified.

To compete in Skippers must be associate members of KBSC.

Open Day: An informal day with racing, but no results are recorded. Racing starts at approximately 1:00pm with **any class boat and all visitors are welcome to join in with their own boats.** Visitors are welcome to sail with us on three separate dates, after that we would like you to become a club member. Contact the Secretary for details.

Non sailing days at Kogarah Bay can be due to Kogarah Bay Boat Club holding speed boat races. These events propose a safety risk to sailing vessels. Therefore no sailing events are held on those days

All skippers are asked to help with the club duties.

These include putting out and bringing in the marker buoys and washing and putting away the dingy and motor. If you can't stay after racing, come early and help. If you can't come early, stay after racing and help.

When KBSC has a working bee, help out for an hour if you can.

Change of boat: A skipper is allowed one change of boat during the year. Once the new boat has been sailed in Championship and/or PointScore racing the skipper must continue to race the new boat for the remainder of the year. If the new boat is damaged then the old boat can be substituted until repairs are completed to the new boat.
